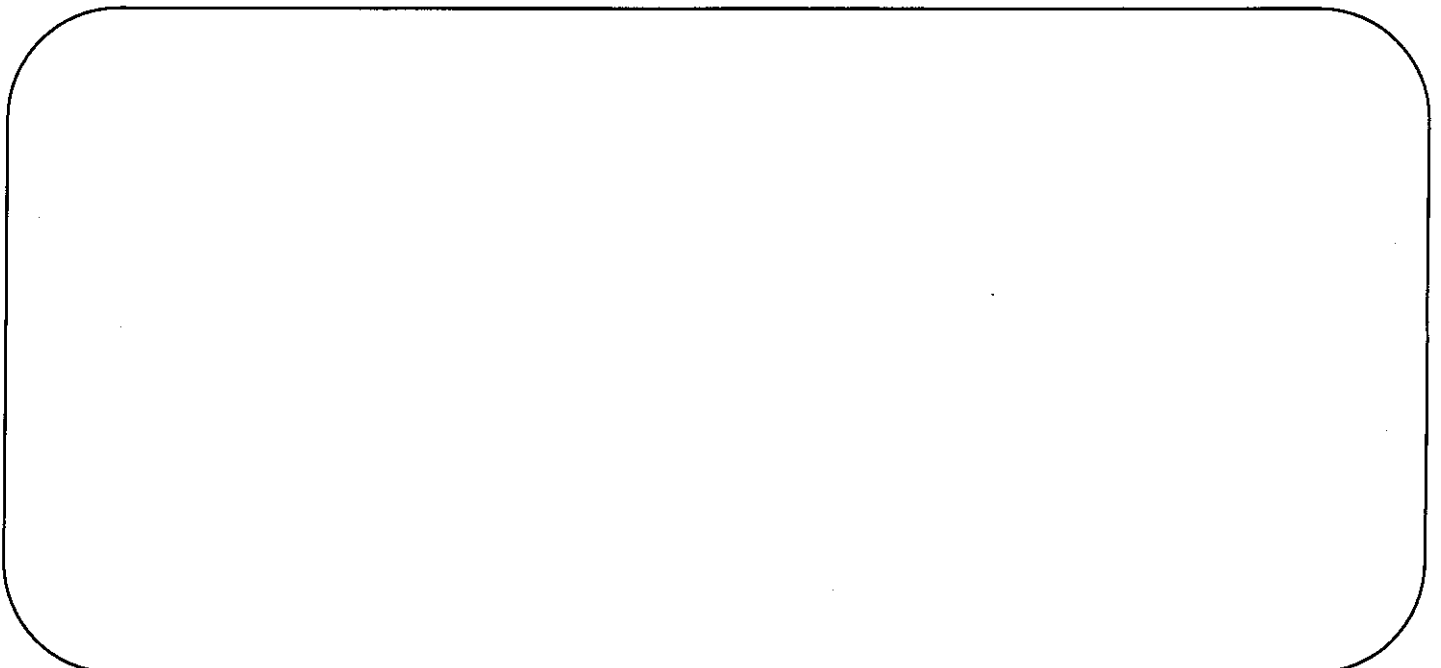
A Bug Can

This bug has a web. It will sit on the web. It will get fed.


A bug can sit on my lap. A bug can do a lot.
