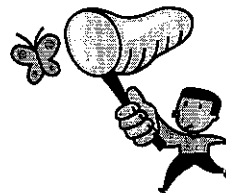
Words to know by sight: Have your student read the following words. Try to use each word in a sentence. You may start the sentence for your child.
